


Extended Quantity Increments

Installation and User Guide



Installation Guide

1. Download and unpack the compressed package
2. Look into the newly unpacked folder you should see the following:



3. Connect to your host via FTP/SFTP
4. Upload all files to your Magento root directory.
5. Confirm that the files have been transferred successfully
6. Close the connection
7. Log into your Magento's site backend
8. In the main navigation bar, select **System > Cache Management**
9. Click the **Flush Magento Cache** button located at the top right of the screen
10. Log out of the Magento backend
11. Log back in, and the extension will be installed

Extension User Guide

Qty Increment per Customer Group extension adds "Customer Groups" selection to Magento's Qty Increment configuration settings, allowing set qty increment to specific customer groups only. This overrides the global qty increments value. This module also add a qty increments selector to each customer to override individual customer's customer group qty increment.

Locating the Extension

To modify the quantity for a customer group, log into the backend of Magento. In the main navigation bar, select **System > Configuration**. Under the Configuration side bar, scroll until you reach **Catalog > Inventory**. The extension will be located under **Product Stock Options**.

Enabling the Extension

In order for the extension to work, be sure to change the **Enable Qty Increments** setting to **Yes**. **Changes will not take effect if it is not enabled**. Be sure to save your changes by selecting the **Save Config** button at the top-right of the screen.

Creating Customer Group Sets

Now that the setting has be enabled, it is time to set order quantities based on customer group. Click the **Add Qty Increment** button if a customer group has not been established. Select the defined group under the drop down selection, and set the quantity. **Be sure to hit Save Config at the top of the screen or the changes will not be saved!** Repeat this step for all customer groups needed.

Overriding Rules Based on Customer

Sometimes it will be necessary for a customer to place an order that does not meet the set quantity rate. Therefore, we have added the feature to override the customer group quantity on a single customer. To override the value select **Customer > Manage Customer**. Select the customer you want to apply the custom rule. In the side bar select **Account Information**. Find the **Qty Increment** field and input the custom amount. Hit the **Save Customer** button to save the settings. Once this is done, the customer will only be able to buy products based on the custom quantity.
